2024 Scholarship Application

The deadline for submitting an application for consideration for a scholarship is Friday, March 15, 2024.

The Danniel J. Petro Scholarship of the West Orange Foundation

The Danniel J. Petro Scholarship fund was established to make it possible for eligible students from local high schools in Orange County, both public and private, to further their education at one of the following educational institutions: Valencia College, Orange Technical College, or the University of Central Florida.

The West Orange Foundation is able to fund this scholarship program through the generosity of the Petro Family Foundation and its corporate sponsors. Program administration and implantation is done in partnership with the West Orange Chamber of Commerce.

The Scholarship

In order to qualify, recipients must live in and attend a high school in one of our service area communities. Service area communities are defined as: Dr. Phillips, Gotha, Horizon West, Lake Avalon, MetroWest, Oakland, Ocoee, Orlo Vista, Pine Hills, Windermere, and Winter Garden. These communities may include zip codes of 32836, 34734, 32835, 34740, 34760, 34761, 32811, 32808, 32818, 34786, 34787, 34777, 34778. However, this list may not be all inclusive of the codes for each area. Students must have a current minimum GPA of 2.75, either weighted or unweighted. While these two stipulations must be met, additional requirements are listed within the application.

Typically, multiple scholarships are awarded from the Petro Family Foundation. The Scholarship Review Board examines and reviews all eligible applications. Selections are made competitively and may be based on academic performance, personal statement, extracurricular activities, and letters of recommendation. Any unspent funds will be allocated to the following year.

SAT / ACT Scores

The Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) and American College Testing Assessment Test (ACT) are an important academic requirement for the review process of the application. Applicants should include the student copy of these tests results with the application. If SAT and ACT test scores are listed on the high school transcript, it is not necessary to provide a student copy of the results.

Determination of Scholarship Recipients

The Scholarship Review Board will determine award recipients from the pool of qualified applicants received and any available funding. Scholarship funds are directly deposited into the award recipient's school account once administrative processes have been completed. Award recipients must be registered for classes. Any questions regarding the accessibility of funds should be directed to the school's Financial Assistance Office.

For scholarship consideration, interested students must complete an application and provide all supporting documents. Submissions will be accepted by email US Mail and email. Applications arriving after Friday, March 15, 2024 will not be considered for the 2024 scholarship season.

Your application is considered complete when the application and the following materials are received by the West Orange Foundation.

I. In one submission, return the following items (I, II, III, IV, V):

- ____ Student copy of test scores (SAT or ACT) preferably both
- ____ Two (2) signed letters of recommendation
- ____ Personal Essay (within application)
- ____ Financial documents (FAFSA, SAI, Tax Return, Taniff, Medicaid, SNAP, etc.)
- ____ College letter of acceptance; proof of application
- ____ This checklist returned with your application

II. Official High School Transcripts

High School transcripts are used to measure an individual's scholastic achievements, interests and progress. Transcripts must be current and show a GPA minimum of 2.75 (weighted or unweighted).

III. Applicant Test Scores

SAT or ACT test scores are required as part of the application process. If you have not taken the test before the deadline, your application may be deemed ineligible. A student copy of the results is acceptable. <u>Screen shots are not preferred.</u>

IV. Financial Documentations

You must submit evidence of financial need. You may use FAFSA with SAI (preferred), SAR, Tax Returns, TANIFF, Medicaid, or SNAP information.

V. College Application Proof

Your application should include proof you have applied to one of the qualifying educational institutions (Valencia College, Orange Technical College or the University of Central Florida).

Applications received after the deadline will be considered late and ineligible. Applications sent via physical mail must arrive at the West Orange Chamber of Commerce office by the posted deadline. Any applications received by physical mail after the posted deadline date will be considered late and ineligible.

Helpful Hints for Completing the Danniel J. Petro Scholarship Application

Please read this in its entirety prior to completing your application.

- Follow all directions in the application packet carefully to ensure your application is submitted correctly. All applications materials must be submitted at the same time. Applications received without all requested items will be considered incomplete.
- The application requires a physical signature from the applicant. While the application is formatted to allow for typing and completing the application, electronic signatures are not accepted. It is advisable to type your responses and then print, sign and scan the application if you are returning the application via email.
- Once the West Orange Foundation receives your application materials, processing will take approximately 7 to 14 days. Applications submitted closer to the deadline may take an additional two weeks for processing. Once your application has been processed, notification of receipt and the status of your application will be sent via electronic mail.
- All applicants must be residents of and attend schools in the eligible locations listed in the application. Applicants who do not meet these criteria will be considered ineligible. Example: A student lives in an eligible location, however the student attends school in an area outside the eligible area. The application status will be Ineligible.
- Presentation materials are not necessary when assembling your application. All staples, binders, jackets, plastic sleeves, report covers or other materials used to assemble applications are removed and discarded prior to presenting them to review board members.
- Applicants are encouraged to not send any photographs of themselves, or have them included on any documents submitted. Photographs will be removed prior to the application being reviewed by the Scholarship Review Board.
- Letters of recommendation should be written on your behalf by non-family members. All letters of recommendation must include the signature of the letter writer. Letters with no signature or an electronic signature may be rejected.
- Please do not request any additional recommendations be sent to the West Orange Foundation independent of the two required recommendations submitted with your application. Letters in excess of this amount may not be reviewed. You are encouraged to use your two best recommendations. Letters should be from someone who knows you well and can speak about your character, integrity, academics, goals, motivation and your ability to succeed as a scholarship recipient.
- One recommendation must be from a teacher, principal or academic advisor.
- Thumb drives or web links to your application are not acceptable.
- The application checklist is an integral part of the application and must be completed and returned with the rest of the application materials.
- Applications received without all supporting documents (at the same time) are considered incomplete. When approaching individuals who will provide information for your application, let them know you need the information back in order to submit the application. Let them know your application must be submitted with all supporting documents.

- SAT, ACT, TABE, or PERT Test Scores. You are advised to submit all tests' scores if you took both tests. Student copies of the results may be submitted in lieu of obtaining them from the testing facility. If these scores are listed on your official High School Transcripts, it is not necessary to submit student copies.
- The application listed on the West Orange Foundation webpage of the West Orange Chamber of Commerce website is a fill-in form. This means that you may type directly into the application, print and sign it to prepare it for submitting it with any supporting documents. To cut down on errors, you are encouraged to type or neatly print your information onto the application. Use black or blue ink if you are completing the application by hand.
- All applicants are encouraged to apply early. Extensions beyond the application deadline are not possible. Applications received after this date will not be considered for a scholarship.
- All submitted applications will be reviewed and evaluated for compliance with the Danniel J. Petro Foundation criteria for eligibility. Qualified applicant's application materials will be further evaluated by the Scholarship Review Board.
- Prior to submission, applicants are encouraged to proofread their application for accuracy, mistakes and misspellings. It is advisable to have an independent person to also review your application as well. Fresh eyes sometimes catch mistakes you may not.
